Curbside Recycling

- Paper: newspapers and inserts
- Glass: clear, green and brown
- Metal Cans: aluminum, steel
- Plastic bottles and jugs #1-7: plastics must have a screw-on top or be bottle-shaped with a neck that is smaller than the base. (No egg cartons, plastic bags, yogurt/sour cream/butter tubs or other food containers that do not have a screw-on top and are not shaped like a bottle.)

1. Ball Park Rd./Lexington - Ball Park Rd, off Hwy 1
2. Chapin - Distant Lane, off Westwoods Drive
3. Edmund - Landfill Lane, off SC 302
4. G. Bailey/Gaston - Hwy 321 and Theo Jumper Rd
5. Hollow Creek - Beulah Church Rd, off Hwy 378
6. Irmo/St. Andrews - Old Bush River Rd.
7. Leesville - South Lee St., 2 miles south of US 1
8. Pelion - SC 302, approx. 1 mile south of Pelion
9. Red Bank - SC 60, 1 mile south of Red Bank
10. Riverchase - Hwy 378 at I-20, adj. to Park-n-Ride
11. Sand Hills/Cayce - Pine Ridge Drive, off SC 321
12. Summit/Gilbert - 419 Sandpit Rd.

Sunday 3:00 to 7:00pm; Closed Tuesday & Thursday

What they accept:

- Paper: newspaper and inserts
- Glass: clear, green and brown glass
- Metal: aluminum, steel
- Plastic bottles and jugs #1-7: plastics must have a screw-on top or be bottle-shaped with a neck that is smaller than the base. (No egg cartons, plastic bags, yogurt/sour cream/butter tubs or other food containers that do not have a screw-on top and are not shaped like a bottle.)
- Other: batteries (vehicle and small lead acid, ni-cad and alkaline); foam rubber, metals (stoves, grills, etc.); used motor oil (5 gallon limit), oil filters and oil bottles; black nursery containers and bedding trays; textiles (clothing, shoes, sheets, etc.).
- Landfill accepts tires, white goods.
